

Men's Garden Club of Santa Rosa Scholarship Application For 2020

The Men's Garden Club of Santa Rosa will offer Scholarships to high school graduates of Sonoma County schools for the upcoming 2020-2021 college year. Individual scholarships of \$500 to \$1,000 will be awarded based upon available funds and applications. The scholarships will be made available when the selected applicant enrolls full time (12 credit hours) in a college or university as evidenced by submitting a copy of their class schedule. Former recipients currently enrolled in a college or university may also apply but the priority is for new applicants.

The following requirements will guide applicants who may want to apply:

1. Scholarships will be available to men and women graduates of any one of the Sonoma County high schools including Charter Schools and Home Schools.
2. Recipient must enroll in college in the fall of 2020 in a course leading to a degree in Agriculture (e.g., Ornamental Horticulture, Landscape Architecture, Forestry, Floriculture, Pomology, Viticulture, Soil Science, Entomology). Other related studies such as Animal Husbandry will be considered at the discretion of the scholarship committee.
3. Selection will be based upon the following:
 - a. Course objective
 - b. Participation in school activities and clubs (e.g. 4-H, FFA, Youth Community Organizations, etc.).
 - c. Scholarship
 - d. Selected finalists will be interviewed at the discretion of the scholarship committee of the Men's Garden Club.
4. Each applicant must complete all of the pages below (pages 2-4) and provide a copy of your most recent transcript and any other attachments and submit the package electronically to: Wayne Britton at Ceway@pacbell.net with the word scholarship in the subject line. If it is not possible to email the documents, you may mail them to: Wayne Britton, PO Box 1711, Sebastopol, CA 95471. The complete package must be in our hands by April 30, 2020. If you have any questions, please send an email with your phone number included and the word scholarship in the subject line.
5. Notifications will be made by May 30th or before via email and certificates of the award will be presented at the Men's Garden Club meeting on June 9th at 7 pm. Please plan to attend this meeting to receive your award letter. The meeting is held at the Luther Burbank Arts and Garden Center at 2050 Yulupa Avenue in Santa Rosa. Please let us know if you can not attend. Parents are invited.
